How to Trace the History of Your Car by Philip Riden. (Second edition 1998, now out of print). Includes lists indicating which motor registration authority issued which numbers, and which vehicle registration registers still exist.

A History of Motor Vehicle Registration in the United Kingdom by L H Newall. (Third edition 2008). Includes lists indicating when each registration number was issued, and from which issuing registration authority. Not included is the location of the surviving vehicle registration registers.

Glass's Vehicle Check Books. Can be used to indicate when a vehicle was manufactured, based on its chassis number. The books, which are out of print come in three versions. Glass's Car Check Book (1933 onwards); Glass's Commercial Vehicle Check Books (1937 onwards); and Glass's Motor Cycle Check Book (1946 onwards).
